Summary:

Conversational Agents (CAs) are increasingly embedded in consumer products, such as smartphones, home devices, and industry devices. Advancements in machine generated voice, such as the Google Duplex feature released in May 2018, aim to perfectly mimic the human voice while constructing a scenario in which users do not know whether they are talking to a human or a CA. Exactly how well users can distinguish between human/machine voices, how the degree of humanness impacts user emotional perception, and what ethical concerns this raises, remains an underexplored area. To answer these questions, I collected 405 surveys, including both an experimental design that exposed users to three different voices (human, advanced machine, and simple machine) and questions about the ethical implication of CAs. Results of the experiment revealed that users have difficulty distinguishing between human and advanced machine voices. Users do not experience the negative feeling referred to as the uncanny valley when listening to advanced real human voice over a synthetic voice. Results from the questions about context and transparency. Drawing on these findings, I discuss the strategies for ethical design.

Key findings from the **Textbook Costs Impact Survey**

- A total of 778 students from 19 institutions responded during the survey period (March – May 2023).
- From January 2000 to June 2022, the cost of textbooks increased **162%**, far higher than the average overall inflation rate of **74.4 %** during that same period.
- **94%** of students who commented on their experience with free materials reported positive outcomes.

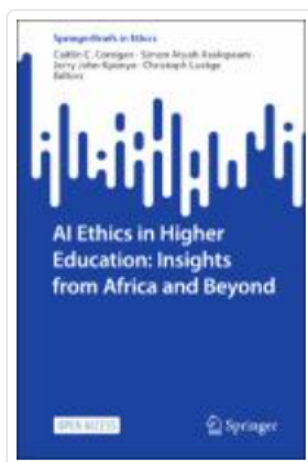

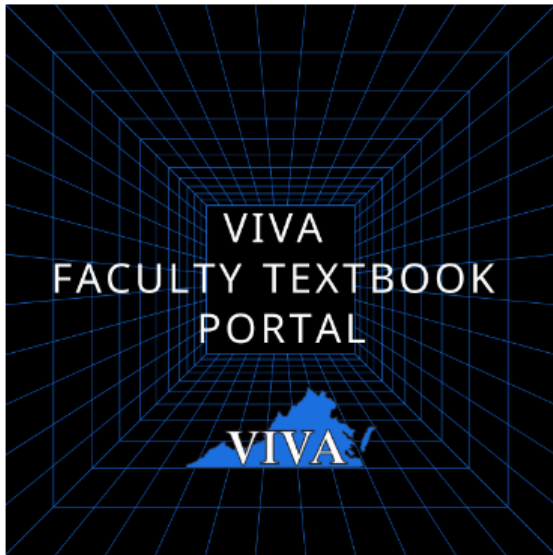

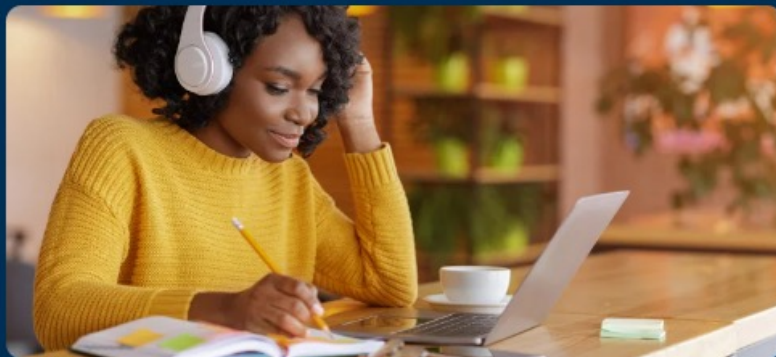

“I very frequently get the question: 'What's going to change in the next 10 years?' And that is a very interesting question; it's a very common one. I almost never get the question: 'What's not going to change in the next 10 years?' And I submit to you that that second question is actually the more important of the two -- because you can build a business

strategy around the things that are stable in time. ... [I]n our retail business, we know that customers want low prices, and I know that's going to be true 10 years from now.

They want fast delivery; they want vast selection. It's impossible to imagine a future 10 years from now where a customer comes up and says, 'Jeff I love Amazon; I just wish the prices were a little higher,' [or] 'I love Amazon; I just wish you'd deliver a little more slowly.' Impossible. And so the effort we put into those things, spinning those things up, we know the energy we put into it today will still be paying off dividends for our customers 10 years from now. When you have something that you know is true, even over the long term, you can afford to put a lot of energy into it.”
